School Characteristics and Replicable Practices

Academic Excellence

1. At San Gorgonio Middle School we have high expectations for all students and believe all students can learn.

2. Standards Based Grading - we focus on what students learn, not what they do. Student learning and growth mindset is a core belief.

3. In school academic intervention is an area where we have made great growth in the past few years. With the implementation of iReady we are quickly able to help students in need during the school day.

4. Over 70% of our students participate in our variety of extracurricular activities such as athletics, robotics, chess, speech & debate, etc.

Developmental Responsiveness

1. Students are placed in academic teams of 4 teachers and 1 grade level counselor. This allows for interdisciplinary planning which increases academic rigor and relevance for our students. Grade level counselors participate in weekly team meetings where staff plan strategies to help all of the students on their team. Students are assigned the same counselor for the 3 years they are at San Gorgonio Middle School.

2. Homeroom - during our daily 25 minute homeroom we teach character using the CharacterStrong curriculum which has helped bring awareness of the importance of being kind and compassionate to all humans.

3. Opportunities for students to experience activities outside of the normal classroom is a priority to our school community. We offer athletics, robotics, underwater robotics, band, chess, choir, Cadet Corp, Video Production, etc.

Social Equity

1. The culture and climate of our school is excellent. If you ask any student they will say the staff at San Gorgonio Middle School cares about them. Every student is greeted each morning as they walk through the gates by Administration with a high-five or a handshake with a welcoming "Good Morning."

2. We do monthly Student of the Month recognition nights where over 200 people attend each night. Teachers speak about individual students and their accomplishments, their acts of kindness or the improvement they have made.

3. We have a great World Language program that is a district wide program that starts in one of our feeder elementary schools and continues into our high school. At the conclusion of the program the students are truly bilingual.
