Academic Excellence

Developmental Responsiveness

- The team approach at Lake Center allows for students to be involved in small learning communities and develop strong personal connections with teachers.
- To ease the transition of elementary school to middle school, 6th grade students are included in a WEB (Where Everybody Belongs) family to engage in team building activities, explore and learn about the Lake Center campus and receive coaching on the necessary organizational and study skills needed to thrive in middle school (DR 1).
- Students are provided multiple opportunities to engage in Lake Center community through club membership.
- A safety net of counseling and support options are made available to students and families.

Social Equity

- PBIS was implemented to meet the social, ethical, intellectual, and physical developmental needs of students through a focus on specific positive student praise and acknowledgement.
- Lake Center students are supported with access to a Chrome Book in every class for every student.
- Students who are English Learners participate in our AVID Excel program which helps them prepare for re-designation and college entrance.
