School Characteristics and Replicable Practices

Academic Excellence

All sections of courses have common essential assessments.

Learning targets are shared with students and focus instruction and learning.

Whole student focus is aligned with building academic action plan goals.

Home base provides RTI time for teachers to meet with students needing supports.

Grade level department time is incorporated in the school day for teachers to collaborate on instruction.

Developmental Responsiveness

Mental health partnerships with local agencies provide students access to supports at school.
