Academic Excellence

* At Dutchman Creek, we "Grow and Develop LEADERS...One Child at a Time!"

* Teachers and students use data to drive instruction.

Developmental Responsiveness

- * School counselors facilitate lessons to meet the overarching needs of the students.
- * School counselors also hold individual sessions to meet individual students' needs.
- * School-wide rules are uniform and enforced by school personnel to create a climate of fairness and high expectations.
- * Mentoring groups are available to students so that they have a safe-environment and a role-model they can relate to.
- * A variety of clubs are available so that students are exposed to multiple interests.

Social Equity

- * Dutchman Creek is a Special Olympics Uniform School which includes students with special disabilities in all aspects of the school.
- * Dutchman Creek and a local college partner to provide learning experiences for teacher candidates and professional development for teachers.
- * Dutchman Creek provides food on the weekend for students who need extra resources.
- * Weekly grade-level, content teachers collaborate in Professional Learning Communities to calibrate and plan content and instruction for students across the grade level.
- * Data for all subgroups is analyzed and used to drive instruction.

Organizational Support

- * Grade-level meetings occur to make sure that communication is shared with all stakeholders.
- * Weekly newsletters and parent updates are sent to all community partners.
- * Each administrator and instructional coach focuses on a specific content area.
- * School-wide communication is housed in one central location so that all faculty and staff can easily access it.
- * Students are organized in teams with four content teachers that meet weekly to discuss their academic, social, and emotional needs.
